

Modern slavery statement

Introduction

This statement sets out the actions of Omda Dermicus to understand all potential modern slavery risks related to its business and to put in place steps that are aimed at ensuring that there are no slavery or human trafficking in its own business and its supply chains. We realise we are not statutorily obligated to publish a statement however we feel it is best practice for a responsible organisation.

Organisational structure and business

Omda Dermicus is a digital health company focused on teledermatology, telewoundcare and skin imaging solutions. Our business operates primarily in Europe, with a focus on the UK, Sweden, Norway, Austria. Omda Dermicus is majority owned by Omda AS, a Norwegian company headquartered in Oslo.

Given the nature of the business, the Board and management consider the risk of modern slavery in the business or within its supply chain to be low.

Policies on modern slavery

Omda Dermicus is committed to conducting business responsibly. It seeks to ensure that its supply chains operate to those same high standards, including third party employment practices, workplace conditions and, more specifically, the prevention of forced, bonded and trafficked labour.
